Marsico, Betty J., 75, of Bonifay, FL, formerly of Pinellas Park, FL, died Saturday January 27, 2007 at her daughter's home in Pinellas Park under Hospice Care. She was born in Cold Springs, Kentucky and moved to Florida in 1949. She worked at Webb's City in downtown St Petersburg during the 50's and early 60's. She was an office manager for the Credit Bureau of Metro Bay and for Duncan Landscape Maintenance. She was a member of the Pinellas Park Church of Christ until she moved to Bonifay in 1990.
