And come they did, many friends and relatives all welcomed with open arms and great times, taking home lasting memories. Roller skating in Bert Jr's garage with the grandchildren in her 60's, was a bit of a hint for what was to come and keep her so vital and full of life for so long Lois never seemed to slow down and well into her 90's made it known she wanted to be included on everything. Never one to sit and relax, nothing changed as she grew older and would not as long as she had the ability to charge ahead. Never thinking of herself as getting older, she said when looking in the mirror, she wondered who the old woman was looking back, because as far as she was concerned, in her head she was still 16.
