Anita B. Gordon, of Seminole, passed away peacefully at her home on October 26th, 2010, at the age of 91. Born in Cleveland Ohio on August 8th, 1919 to the late Thomas and Bird Dick, she was the third of four daughters. The family moved to Windham, OH, where Anita spent her childhood and graduated from high school. Anita attended Kent State University and graduated from Business College in Cleveland Ohio with a Bachelors Degree. She was an Administrative Assistant at the American Brass Factory in Cleveland before she moved to New York City. She traveled extensively throughout the U.S., Mexico and Canada, before relocating to San Francisco, CA where she was a Corporate Executive Secretary for twenty years.
