Schroeder, Gail E. - 55 of St. Petersburg, FL passed away Sunday June 16th 2013. She was born in Washington D.C. on December 2, 1957 to USA Army warrant officer Clarence and Rachael Schroeder. She moved to St. Petersburg with her family upon her father's retirement from the army. Gail was a graduate of Northeast High School and was employed by her father for several years in the rare coin business. Her work history included The Johnson Mathy Precious Metals Co. where she trained and worked as an assayer of gold and silver until the firm moved out of the area; she also worked at a jewelry manufacturing company as an assayer.
