Edward Hendry Memorial Service details are: Friday, March 11th at 11 am at Grace Bible Church 555 61st Street South, St. Petersburg.

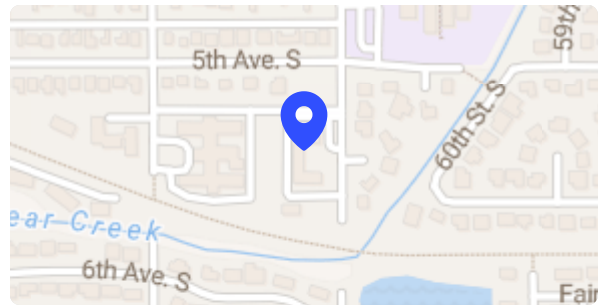

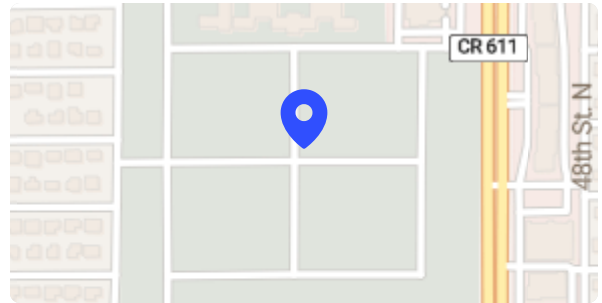
