## Joseph L. "Zag" Harden

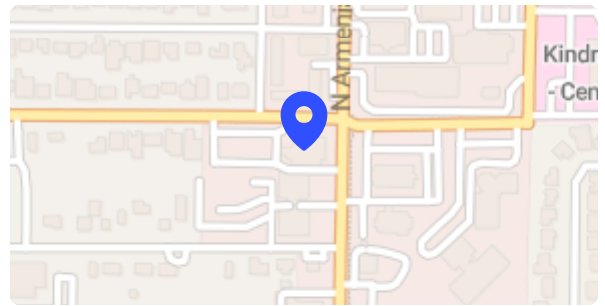

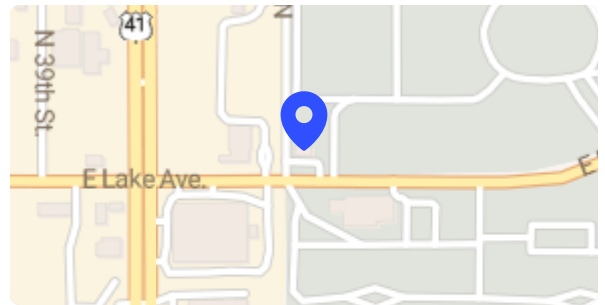
