He graduated from Seaford High School before he attended the Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn and as a member of Tau Epsilon Fraternity, he made many lifelong friends.

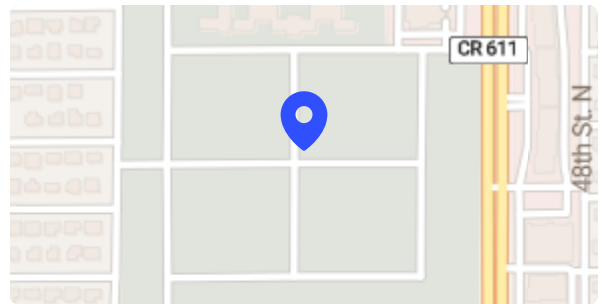

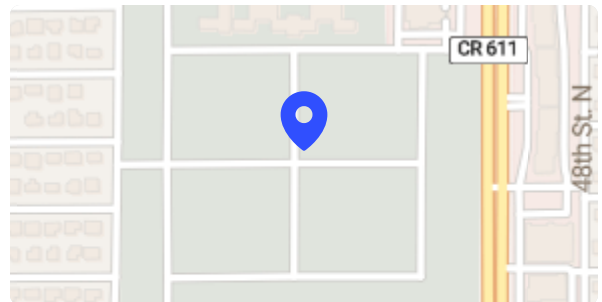
