Evelyn B Hoover, 94, passed away on March 8, 2018. She was born on Easter, April 1st 1923 in East St Louis, Illinois, lived in Detroit Michigan for a number of years and moved to St Petersburg in 1945 with her family. She married a St Petersburg native, Arthur Allen Hoover in 1947. Evelyn worked for Florida Power and was a member of the Junior Womens Club and of Trinity Lutheran Church. She was an avid reader, loved to travel, loved politics and was a history buff.
