Randy was born on December 16, 1949, in Cumberland, MD, the son of late William Michael Price & Betty Jane Price.

Randy graduated in 1967 from Allegany High School in Cumberland, MD. From there he went on to serve 21 years in the United States Army where he retired as Master Sergeant Randy Price, a Green Beret in the Special Forces. 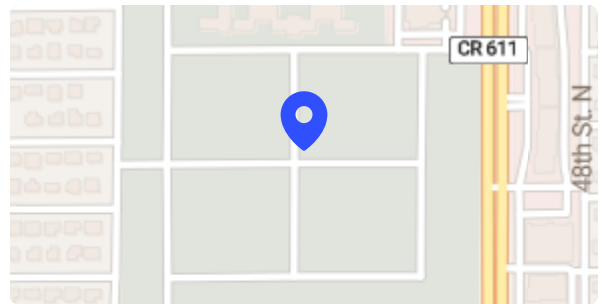

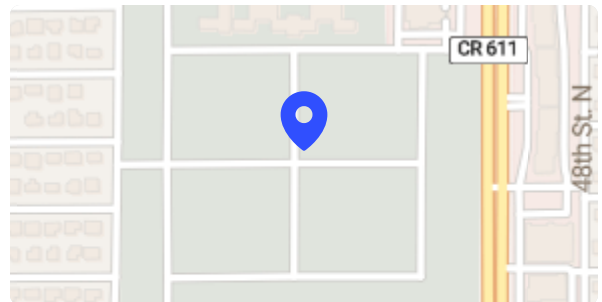
