Anna May Howry, of St. Petersburg, passed away peacefully April 3, 2020. She was 89.

Anna May “Mazie” (Holzhauer) Howry was born on June 27, 1930, in Lancaster County, PA. She grew up in Willow Street, PA and was a graduate of Millersville University. After college, she met the love of her life, Korean War Veteran John Howry. After two weeks of marriage, they packed up and moved to St. Petersburg, Florida where they raised three children.

In addition to being a loving wife and dedicated Mother, she devoted many years to a career of educating elementary school children, which she was so passionate about. She returned to college while teaching full time and raising a family to obtain a Master’s Degree , specializing in Reading, from Nova University. 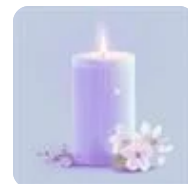
