Allen Reed Jenkins, known to his friends as "AJ," passed away on May 21, 2020, at the age of 69 years at Northside Hospital in St. Petersburg Fl.

In 1969 Allen joined the United States Army and served during the Vietnam War era. He was honorably discharged in 1975.

He worked as a jack of all trades and master of none but retired from the City of Pinellas Park.
