Antonia Swinney, 84, of St. Petersburg, died on Friday, June 12, 2020. Born on January 16, 1936, in Trieste, Italy, Antonia immigrated to the United States in 1953 and within two short years would meet and then marry the love of her life, John Swinney. She worked in Rockford, primarily in manufacturing/factory work but through the years she worked in other fields, often taking second jobs along with her primary work. She worked in Tampa Florida and later, in St. Petersburg Florida, until she fully retired. She was married to John for over 6 decades and had 4 children with him. Her husband predeceased her in 2019. She enjoyed cooking, tending to her home, volunteer work, and crafts. She loved playing Bingo, working at flea markets and having garage sales. She was extremely family focused and everything she did was with her family in mind. Nothing made her happier than to see everyone during the Holidays. She loved to sing, especially hymns and could play the harmonica. Toni loved to yodel and was quite good.

Antonia loved to laugh and was always seeking humor in everyday life. Each morning she got up with a strong purpose and a positive attitude. People who met her liked her instantly and she had vast numbers of friends. They were drawn to her warm demeanor, her sense of humor and the way she deeply respected and listened to people. She was very devoted to Our Lord Jesus Christ and to Our Lady, the Blessed Virgin Mary. She attended Holy Cross, Sacred Heart and also Transfiguration Catholic Parishes. She was an endearing person in the lives of so many. She was an excellent wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, daughter, niece and cousin. Antonia was a natural born leader and she inspired confidence and courage in others. She will be deeply missed. Special recognition to Antonia's Cousin Mario R. Ghinazzi, (POW), 38th Infantry Regiment. When just a teenager, he arranged to bring my Mother and her family to the United State from Italy. He couldn't bear the thought of his family suffering greatly in Post World War II Europe. It took many years to properly immigrate the family to the U.S. Before Mario could finish the process and to see his family arrive here safely, he was captured and killed as a POW in the Korean War at the tender age of 21.
