Svetlana Felixovna Rubinchik was born on February 12, 1958, in Kyiv, Ukraine, then the USSR, to Felix Rubinchik and Leena Michelson. She graduated from Kyiv Conservatory and spent the rest of her life as a piano teacher and piano performer, even after immigrating to the U.S. in 1994. After coming to the U.S., she also earned a BA degree in psychology from the University of South Florida. Having taught piano to thousands of students throughout her life, she was teaching right up until the last month of her life. She is survived by her son, Ross Slava Felsher and his wife Nicole and their two children. She is also survived by her sister Irina Rubinchik and brother Igor Rubinchik, as well as two nephews.

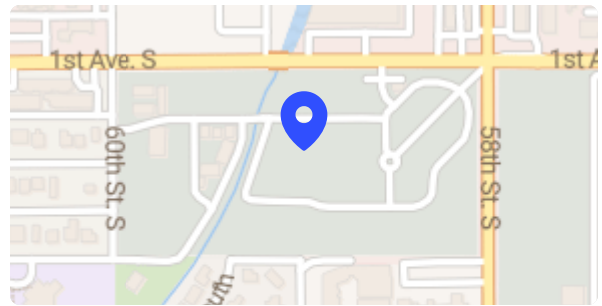
