In lieu of flowers, it is suggested contributions be made to the Starkey Road Baptist Church Planting program.

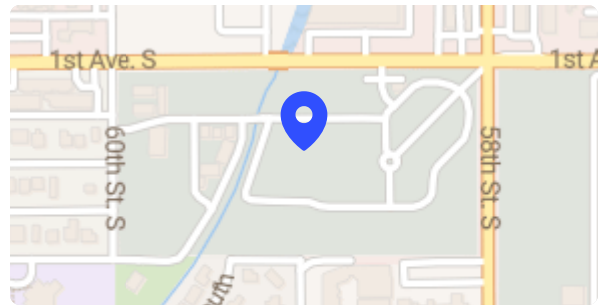

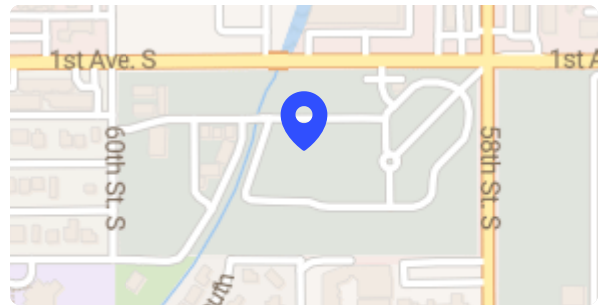
