She was a proud and doting mother to her two children, Sarah (17) and Billy (11), and a loving wife to her husband, Lyman Quackenbush.

Heather had a vibrant personality and diverse interests. She sang in chorus throughout her schooling and performed as a Gondolier at Northeast High School. 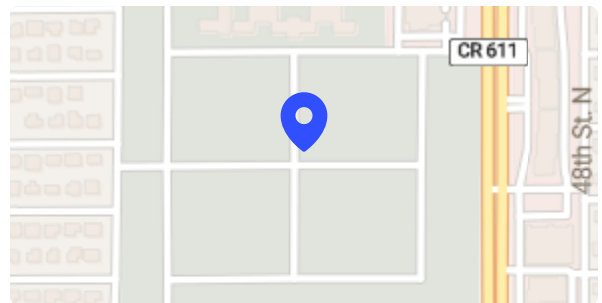
