A very special thanks to the Suncoast Hospice and Bayfront Medical ICU and hospice nurses for their wonderful care.





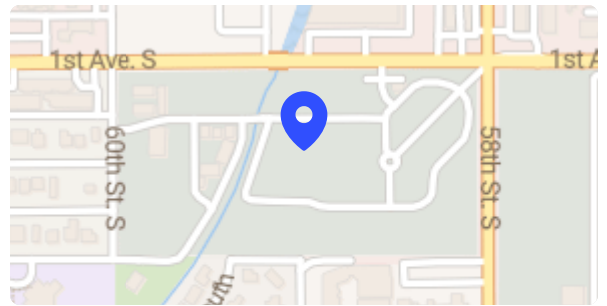
