Even though she was always late, the fun didn't start until she walked in the room. She was always the brightest light, and now that light has dimmed. Lois Ann Coots (77), formerly of Pinellas Park, FL, passed away at Lexington Medical Center in Columbia, SC from leukemia on March 23, 2024.

Lois was born in Greenfield, MA on February 17, 1947, to Robert and Beatrice Lincoln. She grew up with her two brothers, and her younger sister. She attended Athol High School before receiving her teaching degree from Florida State University in 1969. She taught elementary school for over 30 years and continued her passion in education as a substitute teacher and volunteer, up until her recent illness. Her life was devoted to children, first as a teacher, then a parent and a devoted grandparent.
