Rodger Wade Couch, 78, of St. Petersburg, Florida went to be with the Lord on March 25, 2024. Rodger was born on May 3, 1945 in Athens, Alabama to his parents Clifford W. and Sarah Couch. The family moved to Florida when Rodger was 10 years old, and when he was of age, he joined the military and served in the United States Marines at Camp LeJeune, North Carolina.

His life's work was masonry, something he was very proud of, and he was known to always help with projects for friends and family and was always going out of his way to ensure his work was no less than perfect. 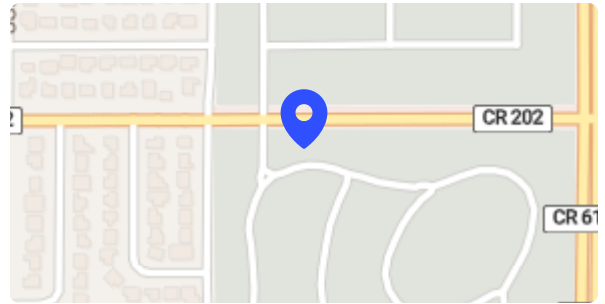

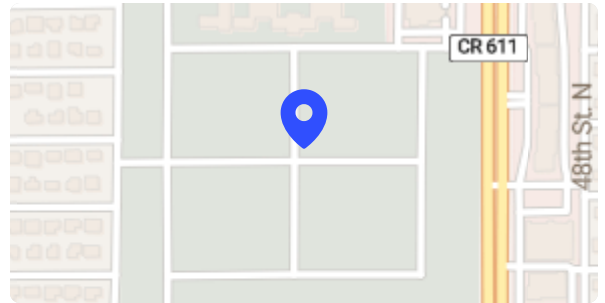

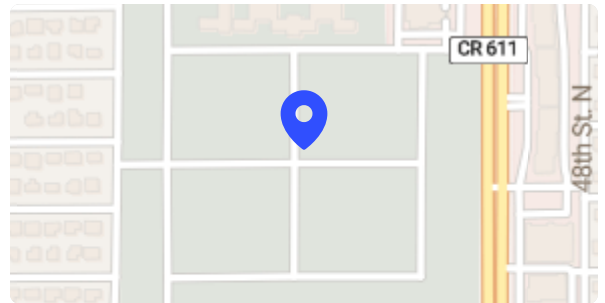
