Charles Franklin Logsdon (Charlie to many) entered his eternal home on September 28th surrounded by family.

He was born in Ames, Iowa, a farm boy during the depression. He learned about adult responsibilities and hard work early, driving tractors, shooting game and animal husbandry. He spent his career in the Navy, witnessing the explosion of the Atom bomb. His tour of duties included Australia, China and Japan. He met his future wife while on furlough and together they raised four daughters. He was stationed at the Pentagon during the Cuban Missile crisis and the assassination of President Kennedy. He was passionate about the military, history and was a life long student and avid reader. He was devoted to his family and his faith.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Doris Logsdon (nee Van Ryswyk) and his daughter, Kay Wightman. His remaining family includes his daughter Stephanie Dasch, her son, David Eisenbart, wife, Sara, their children Carlos, Caleb and Faith. 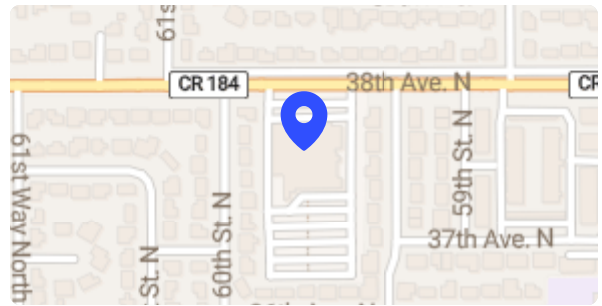
He was loved by many and is deeply missed.

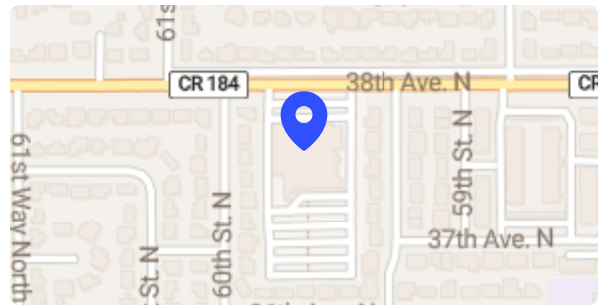

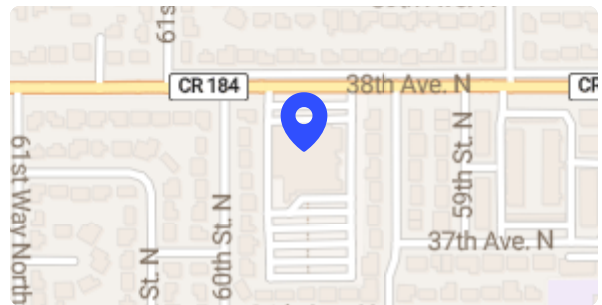

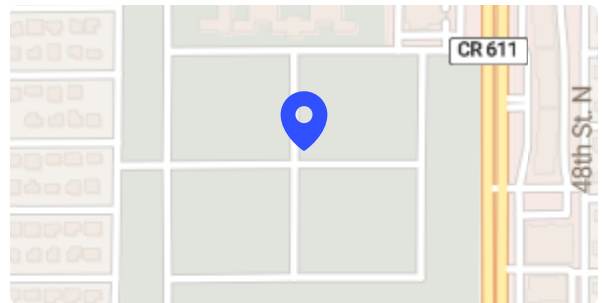
