Earl's legacy of love, faith, and dedication will be cherished by all who knew him. He will be deeply missed.

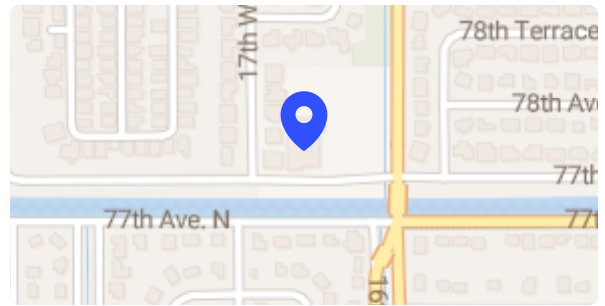
