Oscar A. Estrada, 101, passed away peacefully on Friday, June 6, 2025, in St. Petersburg, Florida.

Born on September 4, 1923, in Cusco, Peru, to Luis Alberto Estrada Galdo and Isabel Ascarza Pacheco, Oscar lived a life defined by integrity, devotion, and an enduring love for his family. From a young age, he took on responsibilities to help his mother support his household—an early reflection of the selflessness and strength that would characterize his entire life.

Oscar spent more than twenty years as a journalist with La Crónica in Lima, Peru. After moving with his family to St. Petersburg, Florida, he worked for the St. Petersburg Times. Throughout, he remained steadfast in his belief that love, commitment, and family mattered above all.

A man of quiet strength and profound family values, Oscar was always ready with a warm smile and a generous heart. He cherished life's simple pleasures—reading, music, fishing, and above all, soccer. A skilled player in his youth, he carried his passion for the sport throughout his life, whether playing, watching, or proudly cheering on his children and grandchildren from the sidelines.
