In lieu of flowers, the family asks that donations be made to Victor Newman Ministries to continue Yvette's life's work of helping others.

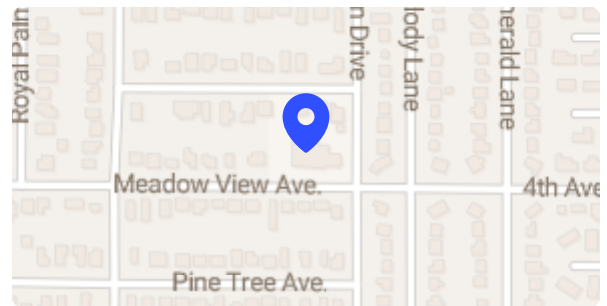
