It is with deep love and sadness that we share the passing of Cynthia Evan Ferris, of Clearwater, Florida, who fell asleep in the Lord on Tuesday, October 14, 2025, after her courageous fight against breast cancer.

Cynthia was an angel sent to Earth, survived by her husband Robert Ferris, and was a devoted mother to Kim Wagner (Michael) who will continue her legacy. 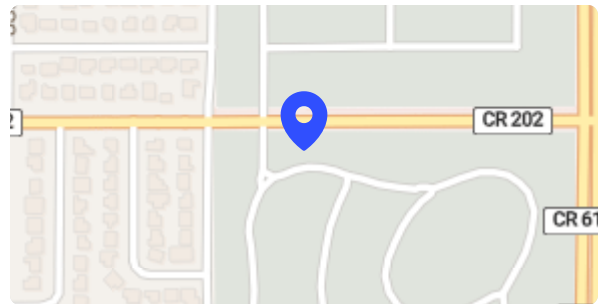

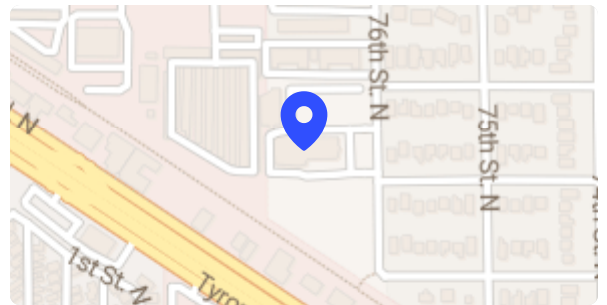

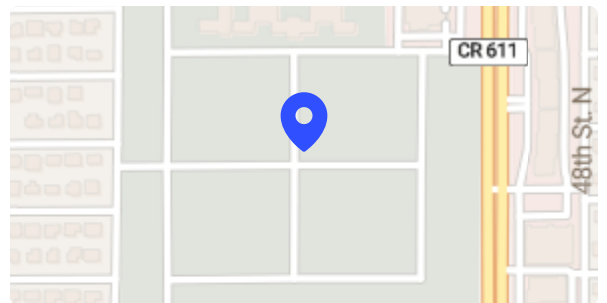
