Carol went on to Duke University where she graduated in 1958 and met her future husband, Langston Holland. They were married in Houston in 1958 and made their home in St. Petersburg.

Together they have four sons: Langston, Jr. (Ellen), Troy (Judy), Albert (Elizabeth) and Elliott (Miranda). They have 11 grandchildren, 9 great grandchildren and many beloved family members.

Besides her family, Carol was committed to the St. Petersburg community. Carol was a steadfast supporter of PARC for more than 60 years, serving as Board Chair in 1965/1966, receiving the Lifetime Humanitarian Award in 2022. 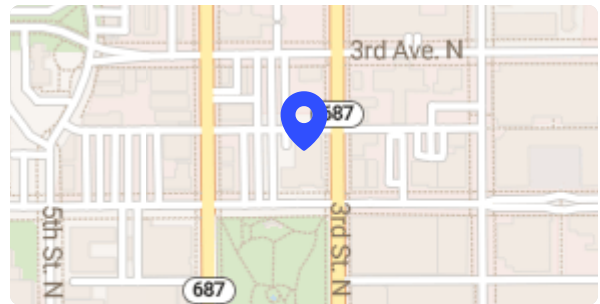
