Michael “Mike” Morroney of Merion, PA, passed away suddenly Monday, February 7, 2022, in St. Petersburg, Florida. He was the beloved husband of Roseanne (Martino) for 58 years. Mike was born in Overbrook, PA on April 23, 1940 to the late Lawrence and Margaret Morroney. He resided in Merion for most of his life where he raised a beautiful family before retiring to the “Sunshine State” 8 years ago. Mike is also survived by his 4 children that he loved more than life Larry (Debbie), Michele (Greg), Margie (Chris), and Michael (Andrea). He cherished his 10 grandchildren and loved spending time with them; Michael, Larry, Nicholas, Allison, Anna, Emily, Amanda, Meghan, Joseph and Rosa. He was a dedicated volunteer for the Lions Club serving as President for a year. Mike’s strongest passion was his faith and family.
